



Oracle Critical Patch Update – July 2007

Detail

Oracle has released a Critical Patch Update for multiple security vulnerabilities. It also includes non-security fixes that are required (because of interdependencies) by those security patches. This Critical Patch Update contains 45 new security fixes across all products.

Due to the threat posed by a successful attack, Oracle strongly recommends that fixes are applied as soon as possible.
